Course policies

1. Active participation is extremely important in a language class. This includes not only physical attendance but preparation at home and active involvement in classroom activities. The French Department policy concerning absences reads as follows: "If, without official excuse, a student misses eight classes of a French course which meets five times a week, the instructor is expected to report the student to the Chairman and to the Dean for deletion from the course. Unexcused absences are those which do not fall under the following categories:

- \* personal illness
- \* death or illness in the family which requires you to return home
- \* observance of religious holidays
- \* participation in University-sponsored field trips or varsity sporting events.

Please inform the instructor at the earliest if you must miss class for one of the above reasons.

2. All assignments are due in class on the date for which they are assigned. Late assignments will not be accepted.

3. No makeup dictées or interros will be given since one grade is dropped.

4. All work for class is considered pledged. You may use reference materials to prepare homework and compositions. You MAY NOT receive help from anyone besides your instructor--should you get a tutor, the instructor should be notified.

5. To complete the language requirement, students may not take courses out of sequences (i.e. 102 then 101), nor skip a course in the sequence (i.e. 101 to 201), nor enroll in sequence simultaneously (i.e. take 101 and 102 in the same semester)
