

# MASTER OF SCIENCE IN MATHEMATICS

The Master of Science in Mathematics is a flexible degree program which balances the applied and theoretical aspects of mathematics and statistics. Emphasis is placed on the development of current analytical and computational skills. Upon completion of the program, students are prepared to succeed in industry, teaching or further academic study.

- Two year program, 30 to 33 hours of coursework, thesis and non-thesis options available.
- Faculty research and student projects often involve interdisciplinary work.
- Partners include computer science, biology, the Center for Marine Science, environmental sciences and others.
- Also includes collaborations, internships and job placement with local industry.
