(a sample): tangō, tangere, tetigī, tāctum, to touch - 2<sup>nd</sup> person plural

<b>Tense</b>	<b>Active</b>	<b>Passive</b>
<b>present</b>	tangitis	tangimini
<b>meaning</b>	you touch	you are touched
<b>imperfect</b>	tangebatis	tangebamini
<b>meaning</b>	you touched	you were touched
<b>future</b>	tangetis	tangemini
<b>meaning</b>	you will touch	you will be touched
<b>perfect</b>	tetigisti	tacti/ae/a estis
<b>meaning</b>	you touched	you were touched
<b>pluperfect</b>	tetigeratis	tacti/ae/a eratis
<b>meaning</b>	you had touched	you had been touched
<b>future perfect</b>	tetigeritis	tacti/ae/a eritis
<b>meaning</b>	you will have touched	you will have been touched
