## Latin 201 Midterm Exam

## The exam will consist of:

A vocabulary section: Latin to English equivalents. This will cover all of our vocabularies so far!! You will be allowed to omit one or use it as extra credit.

A verb meaning section: Verbs from the vocabulary lists in different forms for translation in person, number, voice, and tense. (Because subjunctives can be translated in so many different ways, I will ask you to note subjuncives rather than try to translate them.)

**Verb paradigms:** I'll ask you to do a paradigm of one verb in one tense & voice, subjunctive.

**Gender, number and case:** I'll give you a section from the constructed translation passage later in the test, for you to tell me gender, number and case of words from our vocabularies or words found in (almost) all 100 level / first year Latin courses.

**Multiple Choice:** A section of about 10 multiple choice questions, which are meant to specifically test translations with subjunctive (like the small distinctions class exercise w/ cum clauses, only covering all subjucive uses) or to test other elements of grammar we have reviewed (e.g. ablative absolute, relative clauses, & passive perihrastic).

**Translation 1:** A brief passage of constructed Latin, based on materials we've studied so far, using ideas, phrasing and subjects similar to one or more of our class readings.

Translation 2: A few lines from one of the Hannibal readings we've covered in class.
