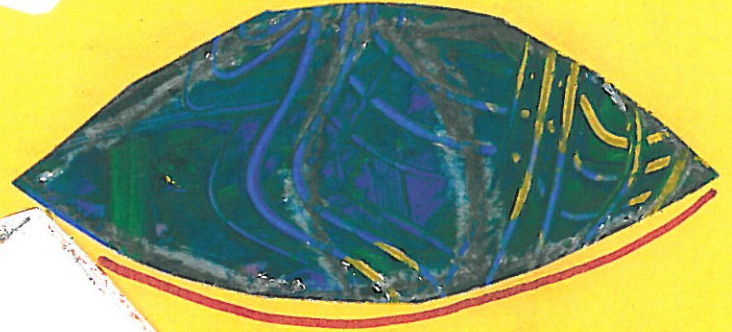
Down, down

North... Wind... eats... again!

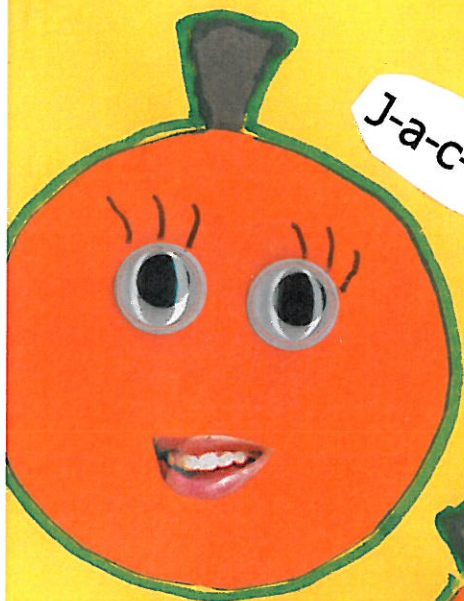

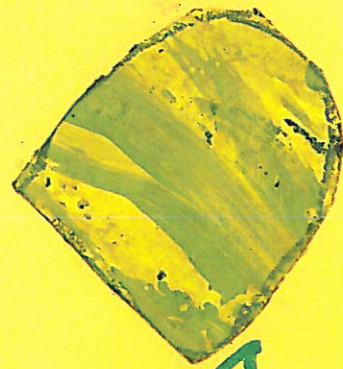
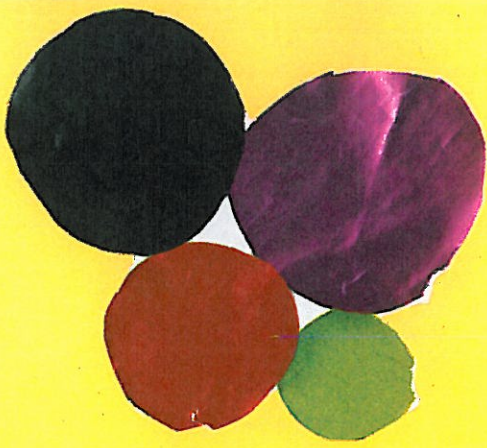


I Meant to Do My Work To-Day
