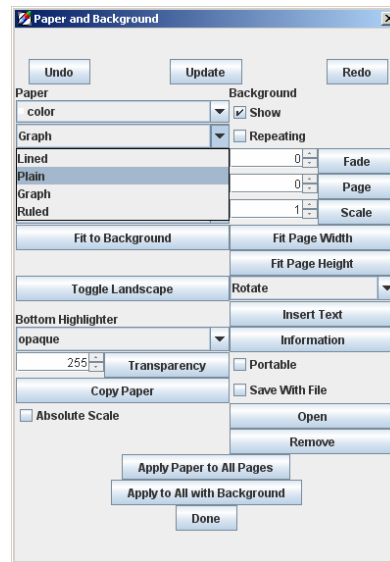
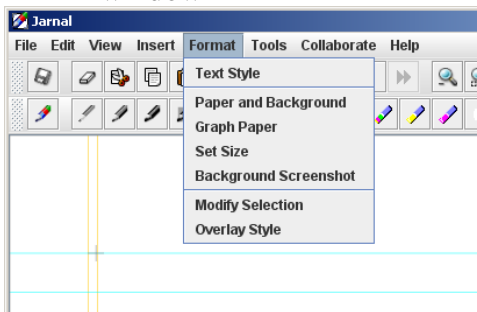

Installation –

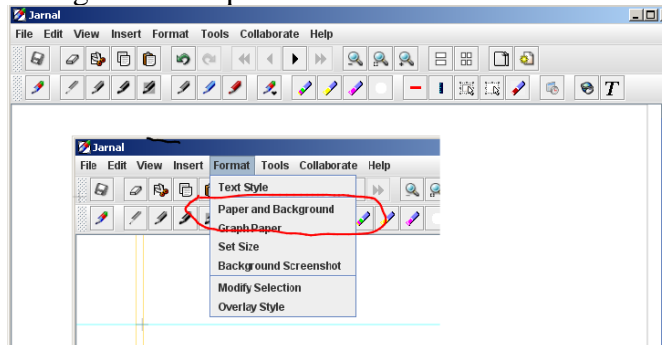
1. Go to Download page <http://www.dklevine.com/general/software/tc1000/jarnal-down.htm>
2. Grab zip file [jarnal-install.zip](#) as indicated
3. Extract to directory like C:\Program Files\Jarnal
4. (Optional) If you want to put a PDF file in the background, then download and unzip [jpedallib.zip](#) as described at <http://www.dklevine.com/general/software/tc1000/jarnal-back.htm>

Run –

5. Go to like C:\Program Files\Jarnal and run jarnal.jar. You need Java installed.
6. Set line style – Format – Paper and Background. Select what you want in new window

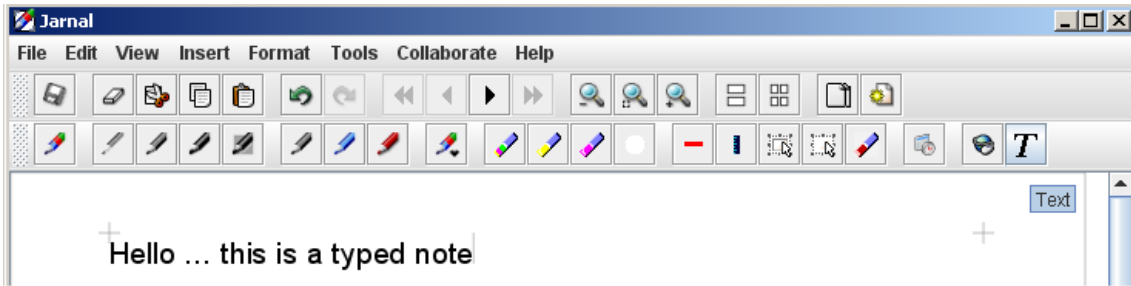


7. You can paste images from clipboard and annotate them

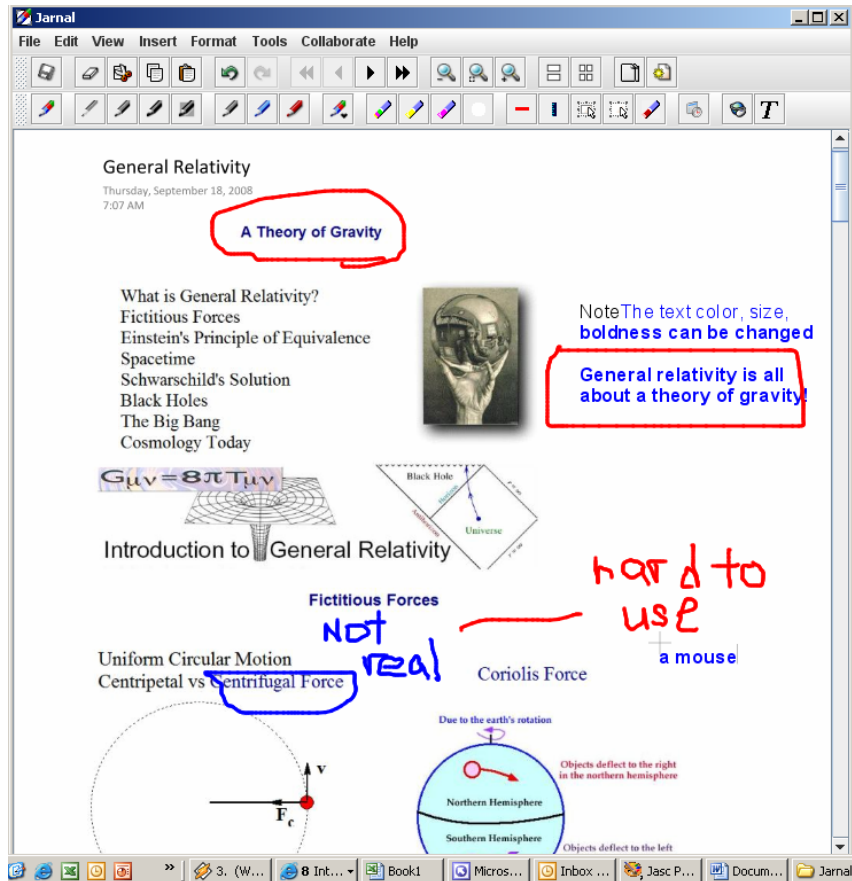


8. You can type text – Click T, click anywhere on page and type.

9. To add PDF (if jpedallib.zip above was installed) – On Blank page, Go to File, Open Background, select PDF file, The PDF appears and you can mark it up. You can zoom in if needed under view.



10. You can save and load Jarnal files from Jarnal. These files have extensions jaj. Sometimes you will see the warning below when there is no problem. Just click OK.
