

## Orff-Schulwerk Course, Level I July 11 – 22, 2011 Chapel Hill, North Carolina



**The Orff-Schulwerk Teacher Education Course** is a two-week intensive program focused on music and movement education. This interactive and hands-on course is designed for anyone with the ability to read music and an interest in teaching children. Daily instruction (Monday through Friday) includes music-making and movement activities based on pentatonic materials, ostinati, simple bordun accompaniments, elemental forms, and special topics. Key elements of this child-centered approach are:

Speech • Singing • Creative Movement • Improvising • Playing Classroom Instruments and Recorder

**Level I Orff Certification** documenting sixty (60) contact hours (from 8 AM to 4 PM daily), redeemable for six (6) NC Teacher Renewal Credits, will be awarded upon successful completion. A portion of the total contact hours will be designated specifically as reading credit. This course is co-sponsored by the UNC-CH Department of Music and the Cape Fear Orff Association, and approved by the American Orff-Schulwerk Association (AOSA).

**Registration** is <u>\$425, plus required textbooks if postmarked by April 15, 2011</u>; May 30, 2011; \$450 if postmarked after May 30, 2011. A partial payment of \$200 will reserve a space in the course. Required texts cost approximately \$60. Remember to bring *your own soprano recorder* and to wear *comfortable clothing* for movement.
