Those **invitations to schedule an interview** will be sent to each student's e-mail address on **Friday, September 13**<sup>th</sup> **by 5:00 PM**. Each interviewed student will be notified of the committee's **decision** no later than **Monday, September 30**<sup>th</sup> **at 5:00 PM**.

If accepted, each student will be required to make a **\$200 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit** no later than **Friday, October 18th**. You will also be required to attend mandatory orientation meetings during both Fall, 2013 and Spring, 2014 semesters.
