Each interviewed student will be notified of the committee's decision no later than Friday, October 3rd at 5:00 PM.

If accepted, each student will be required to make a \$500 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit no later than Friday, October 24th. You will also be required to attend mandatory orientation meetings during both Fall, 2014 and Spring, 2015 semesters.
