FAQ's - What?

- Education 455/592 INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION FIELD EXPERIENCE (GRADES K-12)
 - Students will be required to participate in seminars during both the Fall and Spring semesters to prepare for the field experience
 - Course requirements addresses the 5+ week international field experience
 - Pre-service teachers will be placed in Belizean schools with local teachers. UNCW teacher candidates will teach and assist with daily functions including instructional methodology and practice, classroom supervision and professional development.

FAQ's - Where/When?

- Where?
 - San Pedro, Ambergris Caye, Belize
 - The location is a 'cultural center' and there are many historical, language, ecological, geological, and marine (etc.) similarities with our location in Wilmington, NC
 - Belize shares direct relationships to our state's geographic location
 - We plan for students to engage in three/four required cultural excursions to several diverse Belizean sites

Who?

- Application open to:
 - Both undergraduate and graduate students completing all necessary course requirements prior to internship (ensuring NC teacher certification)
 - Special education, pre-K, elementary, middle, and secondary pre-service teachers from all content areas
 - High achieving / highly motivated students willing to complete required internship requirements in only 10 weeks (as opposed to 15 weeks)
 - Applications will be posted by Friday, August 29th.

How?



- Students begin and complete their "traditional" internship in a Southeastern North Carolina classroom with a partnership (host) teacher for first 10 weeks
 - January thru Mid-March
- Student completes final five weeks of field experience in a Belizean school
 - Mid-March thru late April






Why? 21st Century Standards
