

Bibliography Project

Each student will peruse 20 web sites related to deafness, assistive technology, deaf-blindness, multiple handicaps with deafness, sign language, interpreters, etc. The idea is to research ANY area(s) of interest relative to D/deafness or hearing loss. Your search field is as wide open as you would like.

There should be an annotation with each site, including as much information as necessary to describe its major points, advantages/disadvantages, the focus group, any other pertinent points you find beneficial, and (optionally) your assessment of the site. This may be accomplished by any system you choose, i.e. **, or numbers. If you decide to use a rating system, be sure to include the key. Your comments should be brief, do not write more than a few sentences.

You should use the APA format to cite each entry.

Do not copy the site. ONLY the site information and the annotation will be accepted. The project must be typed. The format is as follows:

- ❖ Single space the citation and annotation.
- ❖ Double space between the citation and annotation.
- ❖ Triple space between each entry.
- ❖ As with any other bibliography, entries should be alphabetized.
