

Final Project

The final project in this class will be a speech given during the final exam period. The parameters are included herein.

Each student will speak on a topic of their choosing relative to the field of Deafness and hearing impairments. This may relate to any discussion in class, be totally different from class discussions, or be an interest discovered during the course of the semester. The requirement is that it **MUST** be related to deafness. It is permissible to do a second performance in ASL if you desire. The same requirements apply.

Topics do not need to be approved, however if you are not sure about the content of your topic, please consult with the instructor. I may offer ideas, as well, but will not tell you what to do.

Speeches must be 4-6 minutes. You are welcome to sign your speech...(please have someone voice for you.)

You will speak from speaking notes, and a formal, typed outline is required along with a bibliography of your sources. A minimum of 2 (two) sources is mandatory. Before speaking, submit the formal outline to the instructor, and afterward turn in your speaking notes.

If you want your grade to be e-mailed to you, be sure the instructor has your address.

As the final is for all members of this class, please do not request early dismissal **FOR ANY REASON**. Should you decide to leave, it will reflect on your grade as one (1) letter grade less.
