

This device must be activated in order to function properly. There are two ways to activate your CPS Pulse clicker.

- Activate it using CPSOnline.
- Activate it using your Class Management System (BlackBoard, WebCT, Angel).

Your instructor will give you information about the preferred method of activation for your class.

The CPS Pulse Keys

You will use your CPS Pulse clicker as you do your other handheld devices that have keypads. Key touches are described here as *presses*. Several keys have two types of key presses – *press* and *press and hold*.

CPS PULSE in the Classroom



On the Screen

Power On

As the Pulse powers up, *elnstruction* and your clicker's Serial number appear on the Pulse Screen. The Greeting displays and Pulse begins searching for a Class to join.

Join the Class

You are instructed to enter a Class Channel # and press **Enter** key, or Press Menu, navigate to the **Join** menu item and press **Enter** key, or You may be joined automatically to the Class.

When Q: _ appears on your Pulse Screen, you are joined to the Class and ready to answer questions.

Changing Text Entry Modes You can answer many different types of questions with your Pulse clicker—single answer multiple choice, true/false, numeric, multiple correct multiple choice, answer series, short answer, and so on. The Pulse clicker will change to the appropriate entry mode when the teacher begins asking questions.

Self-Paced Mode If the Self-Paced Mode icon displays on your Pulse Screen, you are going to be taking a test. You can answer the questions in any order. You can return to a question and change your answer as many times as you want within the time allotted for the test. Use the Alpha/Numeric/SMS Entry key to cycle to the appropriate text entry mode you need to enter your answer (Numeric display, Multiple Choice display, or Short Answer display). Verify the mode you are in on your Pulse Screen. Each time you press the Enter/Send key, your answer to the current question is transmitted. Watch the Enter/Send icon to verify transmission. Press the Jump/Search key and designate the question you want to jump to. Press and hold the Jump/Search key to jump to the next unanswered question.

Answering a Question

- 1 Select the appropriate text entry mode.
- **2** Press the key or keys in your answer. Use the **Backspace** key to make corrections.
- **3** Press the Enter/Send key.

The Enter/Send icon will be animated on the Pulse Screen and OK will verify a successful transmission. If your teacher has set the **Correct/Incorrect Answer** icon $\sqrt{\chi}$, where appropriate for specific question types, it will display on the Pulse Screen.

Powering Down

To turn off your CPS Pulse, press and hold the **Power** key for about two seconds until you see the *Powering Down* message on the Screen.
