1. Application for Admission – due March 1st

Your application for admission is available online through SeaLevel, UNCW's Admission portal. Follow the attached [Visiting International Exchange Student SeaLevel Application Instructions](#) and use access code: **SECRETCODE**

(Make sure to use the 'Visiting International Exchange Student' Application – otherwise, you may be charged a \$60 application fee)

2. [UNCW Exchange Student Registration Assistance Form](#) – Fall 2012 courses are posted on February 27th. Fall course requests are due March 15th.

You may continue to login and change your course requests until **March 15th**. At that date, the form will close while your International Student Adviser begins processing student registration requests.

Important Dates:

- **February 27:** Fall 2012 courses posted in SeaNet.
- **~March 15 – until all admissions are complete:** UNCW acceptance packets mailed
- **~May 25:** Students notified of their UNCW courses
- **July 23:** First day students with a August 22 start date may enter the U.S.
- **August 18:** UNCW residence halls open (recommended arrival date, Wilmington, NC airport - ILM)
- **August 19-20:** International Student Orientation
- **August 21:** Beach Blast!
- **August 22:** Classes Begin
- **December 13:** Exams end
- **December 14:** Residence halls close for all 'Fall-only' exchange students
- **January 12, 2013:** Last day students with a December 13th program end date may be in the U.S.
