  - c. Explanation of item.
  - d. Explanation as to whether the item is a political, economic, religious, social, intellectual, artistic, or geographic event or contribution and why?(PERSIANG)
  - e. Relevance to today explained or illustrated thoroughly.
  - f. Illustration for each item. Illustration can be picture, articles, political cartoons, etc. as long as it relates to the item being explained.

Grade will be based on quality of presentation of materials, explanations, and illustrations.
