

HST 290: Working Outline with Revised Annotated Bibliography

The Assignment: Produce a working outline for your research paper. Include a classified (primary and secondary sources) annotated bibliography with at least five monographs and nine articles from scholarly journals. Numbers of primary sources must meet acceptable parameters for your main research question.

A Working Outline

...maps out the organization of the paper in detail.

...gives an overview of the argument.

...arranges evidence in appropriate places in the argument.

...includes an arguable thesis statement and a title.

This outline must...

...be typed, double-spaced, and in standard fonts and margins.

...use Chicago Style as described in Turabian, 7th Edition (classified bibliography).

...be 3-4 pages in length, exclusive of bibliography.

...include citations and annotations for all sources.

Use Chicago Style documentation and formatting as described in Turabian 7th Ed. Save as a Microsoft Word file and submit as an e-mail attachment to gordont@uncw.edu with the file title written according to this model: HST290_O_YourLastName.

Common Mistakes Made in This Assignment:

- Presenting a thesis statement that is overly obvious.
- Not providing enough evidence for the argument.
- Argument not apparent from outline
