

Checklist: Final Thesis Revisions

- ☐ The title is direct, concise, and reflective of the topic and thesis statement.
- ☐ Methodology is explained and justified in the introduction.
- ☐ Every chapter has a solid introduction and conclusion.
- ☐ The chapters proceed in a logical order, and succeeding chapters build on information explained in earlier chapters.
- ☐ Each chapter has an introductory paragraph that links it to the previous chapter, and a concluding paragraph that links it to the next chapter.
- ☐ Every paragraph has a topic sentence that connects to the main point of the chapter and provides a transition from the previous paragraph.
- ☐ Current scholarship is analyzed accurately.
- ☐ Every statement is supported with documented evidence.
- ☐ Every photo has a caption that connects the subject of the photo to the argument in the paragraphs surrounding the photo.
- ☐ All evidence is cited in footnotes and the bibliography as described in Turabian 7th ed.
- ☐ Sentences are clear and concise. Wordy or awkward sentences have been rewritten.
- ☐ I can write the main point of my thesis in two clearly stated interpretive sentences:
