<p>16:13 Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" 16:14 And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, but others Elijah, and still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets."</p> <p>16:15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"</p> <p>16:16 Simon Peter answered, "<u>You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.</u>"</p> <p>16:17 And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah!
