<p>24:15 "So when you see the <u><i>desolating sacrilege standing in the holy place</i></u>, as was spoken of by the <u><i>prophet Daniel</i></u> (let the reader understand),</p> <p>24:16 then those in Judea must flee to the mountains; 24:17 the one on the housetop must not go down to take what is in the house; 24:18 the one in the field must not turn back to get a coat. 24:19 Woe to those who are pregnant and nursing infants in those days! 24:20 Pray that your flight may not be in winter or on a sabbath. 24:21 For at that time there will be great suffering, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be. 24:22 And if those days had not been cut short, no one would be saved; but for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.</p>	<p>13:14 "But when you see the <u><i>desolating sacrilege set up where it ought not to be</i></u> (<u>let the reader understand</u>),</p> <p>then those in Judea must flee to the mountains; 13:15 the one on the housetop must not go down or enter the house to take anything away; 13:16 the one in the field must not turn back to get a coat. 13:17 Woe to those who are pregnant and nursing infants in those days! 13:18 Pray that it may not be in winter. 13:19 For in those days there will be suffering, such as has not been from the beginning of the creation that God created until now, no, and never will be. 13:20 And if the Lord had not cut short those days, no one would be saved; but for the sake of the elect, whom he chose, he has cut short those days.</p>	<p>21:20 "<u><i>When you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies</i></u>, then know that its desolation has come near.</p> <p>21:21 Then those in Judea must flee to the mountains, and those inside the city must leave it, and those out in the country must not enter it; 21:22 for these are days of vengeance, as a fulfillment of all that is written. 21:23 Woe to those who are pregnant and nursing infants in those days! <u><i>For there will be great distress on the earth and wrath against this people;</i></u> <u><i>21:24 they will fall by the edge of the sword and be taken away as captives among all nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled on by the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.</i></u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Does Luke Know About 70 CE?</b></p>

**24:23** Then if anyone says to you, 'Look! Here is the Messiah!' or 'There he is!' -- do not believe it. **24:24** For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and produce great signs and omens, to lead astray, if possible, even the elect. **24:25** Take note, I have told you beforehand.

**24:26** So, if they say to you, 'Look! He is in the wilderness,' do not go out. If they say, 'Look! He is in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. **24:27** For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes as far as the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. **24:28** Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather.

**13:21** And if anyone says to you at that time, 'Look! Here is the Messiah!' or 'Look! There he is!' --do not believe it. **13:22** False messiahs and false prophets will appear and produce signs and omens, to lead astray, if possible, the elect. **13:23** But be alert; I have already told you everything.
