Guidelines for Chapter Presentations

For group presentations please read the chapter thoroughly, present the chapter to the class using a multimedia presentation module (PowerPoint, internet, for example). You might also provide a brief handout. Be sure to use examples to explain your points in the chapter.

In short, the idea is to “teach” the chapter to the class. Typically, there are 3 members in each group and each group is required to present one chapter this semester. Be sure that each group member has a role in the presentation and that each group member speaks. Be sure to support each other and support or maintain the discussion for everyone.

Each group member is required to submit a one page single-spaced evaluation of each team member that outlines their contributions. This evaluation maybe submitted up to one week after the group presentation.

Here is the grading criterion:

(This is not a group grade. Each group member is graded individually for their contributions).

Final Grades will be reported on your one-page single-spaced evaluation.
