(a sample): tangō, tangere, tetigī, tāctum, to touch - 2nd person plural

Tense	Active	Passive
present	tangitis	tangimini
<i>meaning</i>	you touch	you are touched
imperfect	tangebatis	tangebamini
<i>meaning</i>	you touched	you were touched
future	tangetis	tangemini
<i>meaning</i>	you will touch	you will be touched
perfect	tetigisti	tacti/ae/a estis
<i>meaning</i>	you touched	you were touched
pluperfect	tetigeratis	tacti/ae/a eratis
<i>meaning</i>	you had touched	you had been touched
future perfect	tetigeritis	tacti/ae/a eritis
<i>meaning</i>	you will have touched	you will have been touched
