

How to get to the simulcast presentations on the Asia For Educators web site.

Directions:

1. Use Chrome or Firefox (Internet Explorer 11 did not work for me) as an internet browser. Go to <http://asiaforeducators.org/>
2. Register on the above site by following the directions on the upper left-hand corner "MOODLE SITE Registration DIRECTIONS"
3. Follow the direction there and create new account.
4. After creating a new account, login to the site.
5. Scroll down to find the topic(s) of the assignments and click on the topic. Click on "Enroll me" to get into the presentation materials. You will get an automated welcome e-mail message from Karen Kane.
6. Browse around the site of the chosen topic. Find "Link to Presentation" to view the simulcast presentation. Enjoy the resources on the sites.
7. Send Yoko Kano at kanoy@uncw.edu your teaching reflection (less than one page) by the due date.

Mediasite Instructions:

- 1) Mediasite uses Microsoft Silverlight. (The day of the broadcast, when you click on the link for the desired presentation and the player will open up in your browser.

If you don't already have it installed, it will prompt you to download and install it for free. We recommend, however, that you install it in advance to avoid losing minutes of the presentation.)

- 2) The latest version of Silverlight is recommended. It can be found here: <http://www.silverlight.net/>

- 3) If you already have Silverlight installed on your computer, we recommend updating to the latest version of Silverlight. Again, at: <http://www.silverlight.net/>

- 3) If there are issues with the stream stuttering, make sure you have a fast enough network connection. If that is not the issue, then Mediasite is optimized to run in Internet Explorer. We have noted that it runs well in Mozilla Firefox as well. Compatibility with Safari, Chrome, or other browsers cannot be confirmed.
