

13 Weekly Writing Assignments

Each assignment is worth 10 points. The first three will be evaluated/graded with spelling and grammar deductions. The remaining 10 must be submitted as assigned by Ms. Shauna Turner White.

The class will be divided into thirds:

1. One third will write the first 5 papers on their own and then will submit 5 papers written by ChatGPT. This group will provide the assignment topic and then submit ChatGPT's assignment.
2. One third will have the first 5 papers written by ChatGPT and the last 5 will be written by the student.
3. One third will randomly write 5 papers on their own and will have ChatGPT write 5 papers on the assigned topic.

Assignment parameters:

- 1" margins on all sides.
- .5" first-line indent.
- Double-spaced, but NO paragraph padding.
- Times New Roman, 11 pt.
- One FULL page of writing.
- Spell and grammar check the papers written by you.
- Assignment title at the top, but **do not include your name.**
- Each assignment will have a template for you to use.
- When submitting the assignment, you will be uploading to a separate Blackboard Link (you will all be invited to it).
 - Your instructor will NOT have access to your work, only Ms. White will have access.
 - When you submit, you will add to the assignment's comments if you are in Group 1, 2, or 3.
 - Group 3 participants will add an additional comment that identifies if the paper is self-written or ChatGPT written.
 - If you are submitting a ChatGPT paper, **do NOT run a spell or grammar check.** Conversely, if you are submitting a paper YOU have written on your own, you must run a spell and grammar check.
 - You must submit by the assignment deadline.
- YOU must figure out how to get ChatGPT to meet the assignment parameters. See below for guidance on downloading ChatGPT and how to use it.
- **IF you follow the above parameters, Ms. White will assign you full points for these ten papers.**
